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ACCOUNTABILITIES

Reporting to the Senior Director of Major Gifts and working closely with the Major Gift Team and other key stakeholders, the Philanthropy Officer will:

- Manage a portfolio of 50-75 Major Gift prospects and donors, including grantors and foundations;
- Develop customized proposals, grant applications, and creative briefs for prospective partners;
- Ability to network by building, cultivating, and maintaining relationships with corporations, foundations, and donors to inspire support. Actively network at stakeholder and community events;
- Collaborate with the content and creative services team on the production of marketing and communication materials for their fundraising partner by developing compelling proposals;
- Play a key role in working with volunteers, colleagues to identify donor prospects; develop cultivation and solicitation strategies for those donor prospects;
- Work closely with the appropriate Foundation teams with regard to gift administration, research, proposal development, recognition and stewardship;
- Participate in team and cross-functional projects as assigned;
- Assist in the coordination of meetings and for current and prospective donors and fundraising cabinets;
- Maintain Raisers Edge NXT database records, tracking contacts, communications, and moves management information.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

- A bachelor's degree or higher, with a focus on business, fundraising, marketing, sales or applicable experience;
- Minimum two years of experience of fundraising experience, engaging with donors and managing fundraising programs with a focus on major gifts;
- Proven experience in strategy development and project management;

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- Knowledge of the not-for-profit sector, with a preference for experience in the healthcare environment;
- Ability to lead and execute creative development and production processes;
- Strong collaboration and cross-functional influencing skills;
- Experience with project management and performance measurement skills;
- Demonstrated ability to build relationships with donors, volunteers, and other key stakeholders;
- The ability to work in a fast-paced environment, prioritize and multi-task;
- Able to manage with a high level of ambiguity and independence;
- Experience with relational databases, an asset, Raiser's Edge (NXT).

- Passionate relationship builder with exceptional written and oral communication skills;
- Tact, diplomacy, and maturity in dealing with donors, volunteers, hospital staff, and the general public;
- Ability to think strategically, plan and prioritize, and work proactively to meet deadlines;
